

# BOHLEVALE STATE SCHOOL 2009

## INTER HOUSE ATHLETICS CARNIVAL NOMINATIONS CRITERIA

Due to the increase of enrolments at our school, we will be adopting the following procedures to ensure every student has an opportunity to be a part of the athletics carnival but allow the school to maximise learning time and not have too much disruption to curriculum learning time.

### 1. FIELD EVENTS – high jump

Best 4 students from each house, gender and age group (9yrs – 13yrs), will compete in the High Jump finals at athletics carnival. Trials for these events will be conducted during PE lessons. All results are collated and finalised by the PE Teacher.

*ALL STUDENTS WILL HAVE JUMPS MEASURED TO GAIN PARTICIPATION POINTS FOR THEIR HOUSE.*

### FIELD EVENTS – long jump and shot put

Every student (9yrs – 13yrs) will compete in Shot Put and Long Jump over the two days of the carnival and will be given two jumps at long jump and two throws at shot put.

### 2. TRACK EVENTS – 800 m

Boys and Girls from any house and 9yrs – 13 yrs can be nominated for this event after a trial run witnessed by the PE Teacher at PE lessons or any other nominated trial sessions advised on the school intra net.

### 3. TRACK EVENTS – 200 m

Best 6 students from each house, gender and age group (9yrs – 13yrs) will compete in 3 divisions of 200 m races. Each division will have 2 runners from each house. The fastest 2 will be division 1, next two fastest will be division 2 and next 2 will be in division 3.

Times for the 200 m trials will be recorded by the PE Teacher during PE lessons and other nominated trial sessions advised on the school intra net.

### 4. TRACK EVENTS – Sprints – 6yrs – 13 yrs

Every student has a heat run (IN SPORTS HOUSE GROUPS) with the fastest 8 in Division 1 and next fastest 8 in Division 2. Division 3 will be formed if the number of students in the house is greater than 16 students per gender and age group.

Trials are conducted by the PE Teacher during PE lessons who will time every student and record results to finalise divisions.

*STUDENTS WHO PLACE 1<sup>ST</sup> OR 2<sup>ND</sup> IN DIVISION 1 AT THE INTER HOUSE CARNIVAL WILL PROGRESS TO THE FINAL OF THEIR AGE GROUP AND GENDER.*

### 5. BALL GAMES

Every student from 5yrs to 13yrs will participate in a minimum of 2 out of 3 ball games at the carnival over 2 days. Teams will be formed on the day of the events allowing for maximum numbers to participate.
