### **How can parents help improve NAPLAN results?**

- Inform yourselves well – Visit QSA websites and read all information at your disposal
  - Access the 2008 tests to gain understanding of what is required in the tests and think about how you can help incidentally at home.
- Encourage your child to become more of a thinker/problem solver everyday
- Assist with learning basic facts at home (tables, spelling, etc)
- Encourage reading (not just “school” reading) share reading opportunities, and talk with your child about what is read
- Support your school and your teachers
- Ensure your child attends school when the tests are being implemented. (12,13,14<sup>th</sup> May, 2009)
