Education Tax Refund Families who are eligible to claim the refund will be able to receive a 50 percent discount each year for costs incurred when purchasing specific education equipment up to \$375.00 per primary school student and \$750.00 per secondary school student. Eligible expenses for the Education Tax Refund include laptops, home computers, home internet connections, printers, education software, school text books and stationery. Parents entitled to Family Tax Benefit (FTB) Part A for children in primary or secondary school for the relevant financial year are eligible for the Education Tax Refund. The refund will be claimed by parents through their 2009 Income Tax Return on all expenses that are incurred from 1 July 2008. Hence, from this date forward all parents who are eligible to claim the offset should retain all receipts for purchases relating to their children's education. These receipts should be provided to your accountant when your 2009 Income Tax Return is being prepared.
