## This funding will be used to


- provide learning programs so that  $\geq 80\%$  of matched students (2016-2017) in Years 1, 2 and 3 are meeting or exceeding end-of-year school reading benchmarks
- provide support programs so that  $\geq 80\%$  of students in each year level cohort (Prep-Year 6) will meet or exceed a 'C' standard in English LOA
- provide learning programs so that  $\geq 80\%$  of matched students (2016-2017) in each cohort (Year 1 to Year 6) are meeting end of year school writing benchmarks

## Our initiatives include


- Implementing a structured, uninterrupted Literacy Block across P-6
- Using student learning data to inform the provision of early and on-going intervention
- Providing teachers with additional non-contact time to support collaborative inquiry processes
- Building teacher and teacher aide capabilities in the use of signature pedagogical practices
- Implementing a Student Engagement and Well-being Framework

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- providing focussed and intensive teaching during the Literacy Block for students requiring additional support to achieve year level benchmarks in reading and writing
- using the school Capability Building and Development Framework to embed high quality differentiated teaching practices
- improving student engagement in learning programs through building staff capabilities in the areas of student well-being and management and through the provision of well-being programs for Tier 1, 2 and 3 students
